Year 2's Residential to Kingswood

After dinner, the children finished the first day's activities by feeding the resident sheep and an owl hunt around the forest using their keen observational skills. They finished the day with a hot chocolate and biscuit before going off to bed. What an exhausting day! The children coped phenomenally well and were very sensible in their rooms over night.



The next day began with a challenging 3.5 mile walk—the beautiful, sunny weather helped keep everyone going! While the walk was challenging and the children enjoyed it, they were happy to get back to have their well earned lunch. Finally, Year 2 finished their second day with a trip back in time to a WW2 air raid shelter. They learned about its uses and the equipment that was used inside. Year 2 children that attended, had an amazing time away and we are so proud of how they acted throughout, representing Perry Hall well.

Year 2's minibeast focus days

The children who remained in school learnt all about different mini beasts, including going on a mini beast hunt around different parts of the school.



They managed to find lots of different mini beasts and then made bug hotels with materials that they had found around school (e.g. sticks, wood, bamboo, leaves etc). Finally, the children then made their own mini beast art work using collage with natural materials.
