Collecting your child from school

You will be required to inform the office of a password for your child and the person(s) who will regularly collect your child from school at the end of the day. That person will be asked for the password if not familiar to the staff dismissing. **If any other person will be collecting your child you must inform the office before the end of the school day, that person will be required to show proof of identity and know the password.** This is done to ensure the safety of all of our children.

Change of Details

If you change your address, telephone number or any of the emergency contact numbers, it is important you let us know as soon as possible. It would be helpful if you do this via the school office.

Attendance

Regular school attendance is essential if children are to achieve their full potential. Good attendance in the early years supports early childhood development and early intervention. We believe that regular attendance enables children both to maximise the educational opportunities available to them and to become responsible, organised and motivated learners. We value all pupils and promote high attendance across our school.

Absences

It is vital that you notify the school of your child's absence by telephone in the first instance. If a message is not received, school will attempt to contact you via phone and if unsuccessful, a home visit may take place. We are also monitoring and acting upon persistent lateness. For absences over 3 days, evidence of medication could be requested.

Medication

If your child requires medication in school it must be sent in via the school office so that the appropriate forms can be completed. If your child has ANY medical needs please see your class teacher to discuss them. Medication must be prescribed and in its original packaging.

Spring Term: We are growing

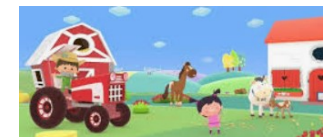
Summer Term: We are explorers.

Helping your child at home

Reading:

- Please read to your child every day
- Talk about the front cover and the pictures in the book
- Talk about the marks on the pages.



Other activities:

- Introduce them to the potty/toilet where possible
- Washing and drying your hands
- Putting on your coat and shoes
- Zipping and fastening buttons
- Talking about people who are special to you
- Talking about what you see in the world around you
- Playing make believe games by pretending
- Creating sounds and singing songs and rhymes.

Clothing:

Please ensure all clothing is labelled with your child's name.

There is no requirement for school uniform to be worn in the Two's provision. Children in the Two's enjoy getting involved in 'messy play' and going outside, whatever the weather. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately and has a spare set of clothes in their school bag.

Please send the following items into school everyday:

- A coat for outdoors
- Wellies
- A change of clothing
- Nappies and wipes.
