Throughout the Autumn Term, children in Year 3 will be learning about 'The Stone Age' as their focus topic. In order to support this, we will be taking part in a Stone Age Experience Day at The Kingswood Trust, Wolverhampton.

On Monday 19th September, we will be travelling by coach to Kingswood where all pupils will take part in exciting activities including:

- Creating a Stone Age shelter,
- Exploring tools and weapons used during the Stone Age,
- Foraging for food – and learning about hunter-gathering,
- Completing a transportation problem solving activity,
- Collecting materials for and constructing a fire, exploring basic cooking and much more.

During this day, children are invited to wear their own clothes, suitable for the day and weather and which you do not mind getting muddy, along with comfortable footwear for walking in. Should weather conditions worsen nearer to the time, please ensure your child brings wellies and a coat as well; this will be confirmed closer to the date.

Your child is required to bring a packed lunch and water bottle for the day. They will have the opportunity to refill this throughout the day. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you would like for them to have a lunch provided from the school kitchens, please indicate on the slip below.

The cost of this experience is **£20** per child, to be **paid no later than Wednesday 14th September 2022**, via ParentPay.

I hope that as in the past we can rely on parent support for this kind of venture; but, should sufficient contributions not be received it will be unfortunately necessary to abandon our plans. If this were to happen, we will refund any monies paid.
