Black History Month Celebrations at Perry Hall

Wow—what an amazing few weeks we have had celebrating Black History Month at Perry Hall. Our children have been working incredibly hard, researching, reading and writing about the life and work of a range of inspirational black people throughout History.

In Key Stage 1 some of our children's English learning has been based upon the book called Handa's Surprise—a modern classic story of Handa, whose part of the Luo tribe in south-west Kenya. Some children have learned about Rosa Parks and made protest banners against segregation.

In Key Stage 2, some of our children have been conducting their own research into people who they find inspiring (including Martin Luther King and Simone Biles), and writing their own poetry. Some children have read biographies, including a biography of Harriet Tubman and also learnt about Floella Benjamin's life.

To end the week, Wolverhampton Music Service delivered an assembly to our Key Stage 2 children performing a variety of music that links to the rich cultural heritage of the black community. It was a fantastic celebration!



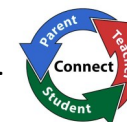
Parents/carers.. come and join us for our weekly aerobics sessions...
