

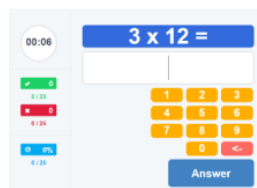


Football Match: Perry Hall Girls v Berrybrook Girls

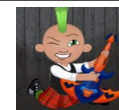

Coffee Morning– Reflexions– Wellbeing

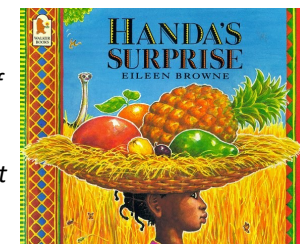
