Thread cereal hoops onto a pipe cleaner or straw using your thumb and fore-fingers to make an easy, tasty snack for the birds. Bring it into school or take a photo of your finished bird feeder.

Make binoculars out of cardboard tubes to look at the wildlife in your garden.

Use an old box to make a bird feeder to encourage birds and other wild things to visit near your home.
