This grid outlines the knowledge and skills that Two's children will gain throughout this half term's topic.

As readers we will:

- Enjoy songs and rhymes.
- Join in with singing by copying sounds, rhythms and actions.
- Enjoy sharing a book with an adult.
- Seek out books independantly.
- Respond to pictures in the book.



As mathematicians we will:

- Take part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- Develop some counting like behaviour.
- Put objects inside others and take them out again.
- Notice patterns and arrange things in patterns.
- Compare sizes using gesture and language – “bigger/smaller”



As writers we will:

- To use a variety of tools to make marks.
- Explore making marks in different materials.
- Enjoy drawing freely.
- Begin to give meaning to the marks they create.



As investigators we will:

- Explore different materials, indoors and outside.
- Use our senses to explore natural materials and objects to see what we can see, feel, smell and hear.



As individuals we will:

- Seek comfort from our key person.
- Develop friendships.
- Grow in independence



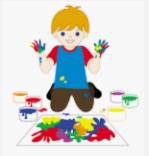
As movers we will:

As creators we will:

- Build and create simple models using a variety of different materials and equipment
- Explore different resources.
- Express ideas and feelings through independently accessing different materials.



As talkers we will:

- Repeat sounds, words and phrases from familiar stories and songs.
- Begin to talk using sounds/gestures and words about what we can see and hear.
- To join in with circle time – singing and story time.
- Use talk for writing to support language and communication.
- Staff will be using Wellcomm to identify and support language development.
