KS1 SATs (Standard Assessment Tests)-Parent Information workshop

In May, your child will be sitting tests in the areas of Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation (SPAG) and Maths. These tests are a Government National Requirement in England and the results are used to gauge your child's educational progress.

As a school, our approach to testing is very informal and children are becoming more and more familiar with SATs style questions and even beginning to see them as fun!

Your child will also be assessed in writing and science which are also reported to the local authority; however, these judgements are based on teacher assessment and take into account a range of evidence from over the year. Teachers submit their final teacher assessment in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science in June. The SAT results are a small part of making a final teacher assessment. The judgements made will be reported to you in the final school report this July.

So that you can better understand what the SATs are, how they are delivered and how you can help your child prepare for them, we are running two parent workshops. These will take place on **Wednesday 1st March** at **2.30pm** and **5.00pm**. We ask that, wherever possible, children do not attend this workshop with you.

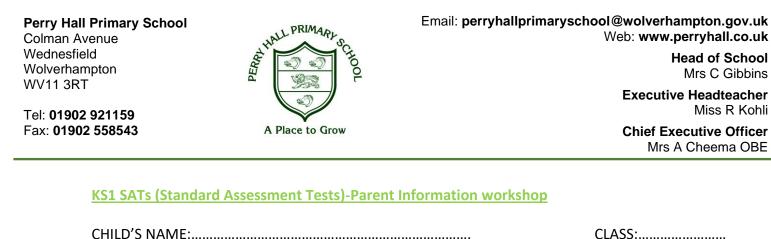
