Children's Mental Health Week 2023 and Inside Out Day!

The children at Perry Hall have had a wonderful week celebrating Children's Mental Health Week 2023. We have discussed strategies to keep our mental health positive and how it is ok to not always feel ok. Pupils across school completed work along the theme of 'Let's Connect' where children in Key Stage 2 played games of bingo, finding children in



their class such as 'a good friend' or 'likes to try new things' and pupils in Key Stage 1 identified people who they are connected to through friendships, family, pets and their feelings towards them. Our Healthy Schools Ambassadors created posters to celebrate this and promote our 'Inside Out Day'; to represent how someone looks on the outside doesn't necessarily reflect how they are truly feeling on the inside. Children in all year groups came in to school on Friday wearing one item of their uniform inside out and used this to talk about how they feel inside and how this is sometimes different to what they show.
