Dear parent/carers



As you are already aware, Tik Tok should only be accessible to children aged 13 and over. We are, however, aware that many children, particularly across Year 5 and Year 6, are accessing it.

For those children using Tik Tok, we wanted to highlight that it has come to our attention that there is a website that is accessible to your child, via Tik Tok advertisements, where inappropriate, indecent photos and videos are displayed.

Please be mindful of this and monitor your child's internet usage.

In line with PEGI ratings, we strongly advise that your children are only accessing social media platforms appropriate for their age. (A PEGI rating gives the suggested minimum age that you must be to play a game or access a platform due to the suitability of the content.)

In school, we will also be revisiting key E-safety messages with the children too and on Thursday next week, 9th March, our newly appointed PCSO (Police Community Support Officer) will be visiting Perry Hall to introduce himself and deliver an E-Safety/Keeping Safe assembly/workshop to our Year 6 children.
