This is yet another once in a lifetime event for our children to celebrate and make lifelong memories with us: we are thoroughly looking forward to the day.

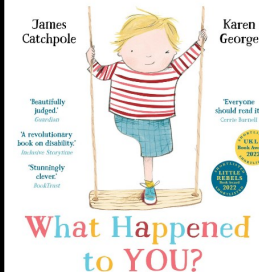
