The children all had a wonderful picnic lunch together, with the weather holding off so our



III the biggest cheer he's ever heard - and Ellie G from Year 6 read a poem she had written to commemorate the event.


Thank you to Perry Hall's PTA for providing children with their keepsake coin to remember this once in a lifetime event.
