Dear parents/carers,

On Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June, we are excited to be hosting a Spanish (Modern Foreign Language) Day across school to celebrate our learning. As part of learning MFL, we aim to provide children with an understanding of other cultures, fostering their curiosity and deepening their understanding of the world. Therefore, the day will include a range of exciting, cross-curricular activities which will celebrate not only the Spanish language, but cultural aspects too, including Spanish music, dance, art, food and popular culture/films.

In KS2, each year group will take part in cross-curricular Spanish lessons. In EYFS and KS1, Spanish (MFL) it is not part of the curriculum, however pupils will be introduced to the subject through age-appropriate activities.

*Please be aware that pupils in Year 6 will be designing, making, and sampling their own Spanish food during the day, adhering to any dietary needs and allergens school are aware of. Please see your child's class teacher if you have any concerns.*

All children are encouraged to wear red or yellow on the day (the colours of the Spanish flag), but are also welcome to wear anything Spanish-related – this can include football shirts, Spanish-related film clothing etc (Encanto and Coco being recent films to take inspiration from) as the day aims to be a celebration of the wider-Spanish/Latin American culture.

On the day, pupils will be able to choose Spanish/Latin American food for their lunch as the kitchen are preparing a special menu. Food choices will include:

- Chicken/vegetable enchiladas,
- Chilli con carne,
- Spanish omelette,
- Spicy Spanish wedges,
- Variety of salads
- Spanish apple tart,
- Spanish sponge cake,
- Cinnamon and vanilla custard

We would like to take this opportunity to thank our 'Español Amigos' - a group of children from Y2-Y6 who form part of our School Council - who have supported in the development of this day.

We look forward to welcoming the children on this exciting day!
