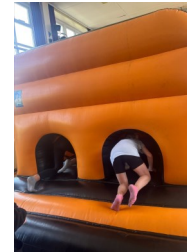
A Place to Grow

Please could you kindly send into school your child's completed sponsor form together with your collected monies by Monday 12th June at the latest. Thank you so much for your support as always.



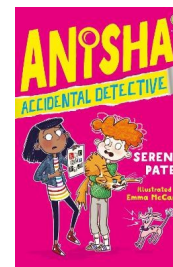
Careers Week—What do you aspire to be?
