Dear parents/carers,

This term in Year 3, children have been learning about map reading and about the natural world around them. To build upon this learning further, we are focussing on field work by looking at the uses of our local area.

On Wednesday 19th July (or potentially another day as this is weather dependent), all Year 3 children will take part in an exciting day where all lessons will focus on field work. In Geography, children will learn about different types of maps and produce their own sketch map based on the local surroundings and specifically Perry Hall Park (adjacent to the school). Pupils will walk to and around the park, then make a detailed sketch map of the local area and use geographical equipment to make accurate observations. In History and Maths, pupils will learn more about local history and will learn about perimeter through practical methods.

Whilst we plan for this day to take place on Wednesday 19th July, we may need to rearrange this date depending on weather conditions. Therefore, please could you complete and return the below slip to your child's class teacher by Monday 17th July.

All pupils are expected to dress in school uniform and bring a packed lunch or eat a school dinner as any other day as they will be eating in school as normal. Please ensure your child brings a water bottle with them to take on their walk.

We hope this day provides an enjoyable experience for your child and will promote their interests in their local area and the natural world. Please contact any member of the Year 3 team should you have any questions regarding the day.
