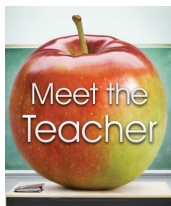


Meet Your Child's New Class Teacher

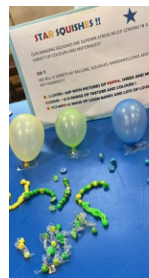
Year 1's visit to Dudley Zoo
