This grid outlines the knowledge and skills that Twos children will gain throughout this term.

As readers we will:

- Enjoy songs and rhymes.
- Join in with singing by copying sounds.
- Enjoy sharing a book with an adult.
- Seek out books independently.
- Use story baskets and props to tell stories and rhymes



As mathematicians we will:

- Take part in finger rhymes with numbers.
- Develop some counting like behaviour.
- Put objects inside others and take them out again.
- Use puzzles, blocks, bricks to count from 1-5 moving up to 10,
- Use props to support our mathematics in the setting.



As writers we will:

- Begin to use a variety of tools to make marks.
- Explore making marks in different materials.
- Enjoy drawing freely.
- Use talk for writing to develop our story recall.



As investigators we will:

- Explore natural materials, indoors and outside.
- Use our senses to explore natural materials to see what we can see, feel and smell.
- Use our environment to explore the effects of weather such as ice, water etc.



As individuals we will:

- Make new friendships
- Seek comfort in our key person
- Play circle time games to help develop our friendships.



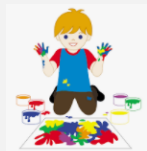
As movers we will:

- Create simple models using different materials.
- Explore different resources.
- Express ideas and feelings through independently accessing different materials.
- Explore different textures to see the effects on different materials.



As talkers we will:

- Begin to repeat words and phrases from familiar stories.
- Begin to talk about what we can see and hear.
- To join in with circle time singing and story time.
- Use talk for writing to support language and communication.
- We will be using WELCOMM & ELKLAN to support language development.
- Use story maps to help us recall traditional, new tales and nursery rhymes.
