Dear parents/carers,

To contribute to our Design and Technology learning this term, Year 5 are visiting **The British Beekeepers' Association (BBKA)** on **Wednesday 8th May (5MJ)** and **Thursday 9th May (5JP)**.

The children will travel to and from The British Beekeepers' Association by minibus, driven by members of the Perry Hall staff, expecting to arrive back to school for 3:00pm. The children will be collected from their usual exit point.

During our visit to the BBKA, the children will be watching a presentation about the production and conservation of bees and how they are important to our natural world. In addition, there will be the opportunity for the children to sample some of the honey made at the BBKA site. This will be done alongside a variety of other indoor and outdoor activities.

As part of the risk assessment for the trip, the organisation have asked us to give consent to administer antihistamine cream in the event of a child being stung. However, this is merely a precaution as they have assured us that there has never been an incident of that nature at the site due to the rigorous preventative measures put in place.

Your child is required to bring a packed lunch and water bottle for the day. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you would like for them to have a lunch provided from the school kitchens, please indicate on the slip below.

There is no cost for the trip but we are kindly asking for a £1.50 donation towards the fuel costs of the minibus, paid via ParentPay by **Tuesday 7th May**.
