**RE: PCSO Workshop: Staying Safe Online**

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to inform you that pupils in Years 5 and 6 will be taking part in an Internet Safety workshop on Wednesday 21st January, delivered by our local Police Community Support Officer (PCSO), Trudy Brittle.

The session will take place during the normal school day and will focus on helping pupils to understand how to stay safe online as they grow increasingly independent in their use of technology. As children at this age begin to access the internet more frequently for learning, communication and entertainment, it is vital that they are equipped with the knowledge and awareness to use digital platforms responsibly and safely.

During the workshop, pupils will explore what it means to have a digital footprint, how online actions and comments can affect others and how what is shared online can remain accessible long after it is posted. The session will also address the appropriate use of social media for their age group, reinforcing the importance of making thoughtful and respectful choices in online spaces.

The workshop will include a presentation, real-life stories and relevant scenarios and will provide pupils with the opportunity to ask questions in a safe and supportive environment. Our aim is to help children understand not only how to protect themselves online, but also how their behaviour in the digital world has real consequences for both themselves and others.

We believe this is an extremely valuable opportunity to strengthen pupils' awareness of online safety and to support them in becoming responsible digital citizens.
