As writers we will...

continue to use Talk for Writing to help us become successful writers. In Spring 1, we will explore character through the story Goldilocks and the three bears. In the second half of the term, we will be learning about non-fiction texts.

As readers we will...

continue to work on our phonics through RWI (Read Write Inc) in daily phonics lessons as well as enjoying a wide range of stories in class.

As mathematicians we will...

use concrete resources to help our understanding in numbers of digits up to 50. We will continue to work on adding and subtracting numbers to 20. We will also learn about how to measure length, weight, height and volume.

As scientists we will...

Be learning the differences and similarities between the different animal groups. We will also explore the differences between wild animals and pets.

In PSHE we will learn about keeping safe. We will learn what rules are in place to help us and why they are so important.

As historians we will look at kings, queens and leaders from different periods of history.
