As writers we will...

Defeat a monster!
We will take inspiration from the model text Beowulf and write a defeating a monster tale, focusing on character description.

As mathematicians we will...

continue to develop our knowledge of multiplication and division. We will be looking at the formal written method and continue practicing our times tables to 12x12 in preparation for our MTCs in the summer term.

As readers we will...

explore a range of fiction and non-fiction texts using our reading domains to develop our understanding. We will also be improving our fluency as well as enjoying a wide range of stories in class.

As scientists we will...

we will be exploring how sounds are made, that vibrations travel through the ear and looking at pitch.

In PSHE we will be discussing strategies to help keep us and others safe. We will discuss what dangers, risks and hazards are in different scenarios we might encounter.

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As historians we will learn about what life was like in Ancient Rome and how life has changed.

As geographers we will learn about Mediterranean Europe, we will look at the climate, location of countries and also discuss the importance of farming.

As computer technicians we will create a programme and decompose a task into small steps to repeat shapes.

As designers we will be looking at different mechanisms to make a miniature playground.
