As writers we will...

continue our exciting whole school approach of Talk For Writing. This aims to develop our children as readers, writers, speakers and listeners by using Macbeth to retell the story using the character toolkit and also write an emotive letter.

As mathematicians we will...

- Look at decimals, including finding equivalent decimals and fractions
- Look at percentages, including finding equivalences in decimals and fractions.
- Calculate percentages of amounts
- Identify and calculate angles

continue to develop our skills in language understanding, retrieval of information and inference. We will continue to improve the children's fluency and speed of reading.

As scientists we will...

look at electricity. Exploring voltage, components of a circuit, identifying why a circuit doesn't work and also investigate how output affects a circuit.

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As historians we will learn about World War 2 – the causes and key events.
