- Learn how to design, adapt and modify our work.

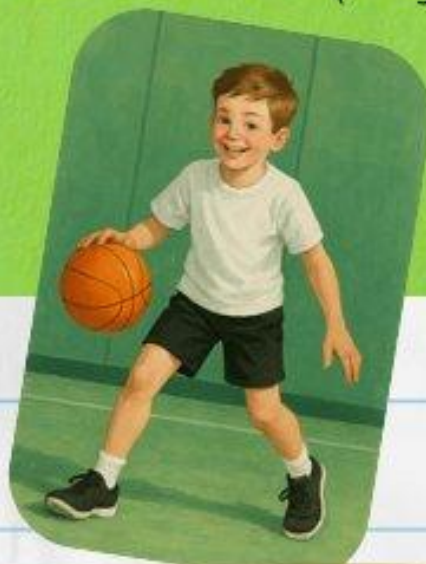
# Key Information
